New interchange unlikely in Etna

NEWARK -- Licking County commissioners might remove a requirement for the ProLogis Park Etna Phase II to keep a right of way open for a future Interstate 70 interchange.

A representative from ProLogis came to the commissioners to ask for the change Thursday after finding out from the Ohio Department of Transportation that another interchange is not feasible.

Although the commissioners intend to contact ODOT themselves, they said they might open that additional land up to development if they find ODOT will not consider the possibility of a new interchange.

Commissioner Marcia Phelps said she doesn't foresee money for the project anytime in the future.

Instead, future money might go toward expanding the Ohio 310 interchange.
